On our last day of school, we will have a 100 Mile Awards Assembly in the gym for students who participated in the 100 Mile Club this year, and their families. Afterward, we would like to invite all families to join your child, friends, and teachers for our annual Family Picnic. Bring a picnic lunch from home and a blanket. Then head on over to the northwest lawn for a picnic lunch. (The lunchroom will also have lunches available for purchase if needed: sandwich, carrots, apple and milk).

Many families choose to take their child home with them after the picnic. Parents who wish to take their child home early must sign the child out in his/her classroom at 11:45 before the picnic begins. Once a child is signed out, the responsibility of the child is transferred to the parent/guardian for the remainder of the day.

Your child's safety is our first priority. Please follow the specific procedures for signing your child out with his/her teacher. In order for a child to be released to another parent, we will need a written note from you. NO child will be released to another adult without your written consent.

If your child will not be checked out early, he/she will be escorted to the northwest lawn to eat lunch with his/her teacher during the picnic. If parents arrive after 11:45 and wish to take their child home after the picnic, they need to sign-out their child after the picnic in the classroom.

It is extremely important that following the picnic, all students who have not been checked out earlier with their parent/guardian return to their classrooms for the remainder of the day. School will be dismissed at the regular time of 3:35 p.m. Thank you for supporting our efforts to keep our students safe!
